Project title:	Guarding, Flexing and Coaching (GFC) study
Project duration:	<i>4 weeks</i>
Description:	This study will explore routinely collected data to determine if using an 'undirected pushing' approach to second stage management compared to a 'directed pushing' approach results in improved maternal and neonatal outcomes
Expected outcomes and deliverables:	The scholar will work alongside midwifery researchers and gain skills in data analysis and manuscript preparation. It is expected that the project will result in a publication.
